



Fukui-Eiheiji Cycling Road

Nakajima, Eiheiji-cho to Prefectural Undō Koen

A leisurely cycle on a hot summer's day brings views of mountains and rivers along the route from Undō Koen to Eiheiji-cho. Before you know it, the terminus draws near, and your first thought is of when you can ride this trail again.

A cycling road links Eiheiji-cho to Fukui City's Undō Koen, passing by the Naruka Dam along the banks of the Kuzuryū river. Stretching 26km in total, the Eiheiji-Fukui Cycling Road offers cyclists breathtaking views of shibazakura and rapeseed flowers against sweeping natural landscapes.
